

Q1 What class is your child in?





Q3 What do you think about the amount of work being set (government guidelines state that all schools with children of this age have to set 4 hours daily)?







Q5 What do you think about the staff interaction with the children each day, and during lessons?





Q6 What do you think about the support that Carbeile is providing to parents?





Q7 What do you think about the communication from Carbeile throughout the lockdown(s)?




