

### **Targets**

Your child might have come home beaming this week after achieving their Bronze Token to add to their new eco-friendly target system. To do this so early is a major achievement and shows a wonderful learning attitude and commitment to improve. I couldn't be more proud of all of the children who are striving for this first token.

For those parents who don't know about our system, it is all based on the mastery of knowledge or skills that are set for each individual child based on their own need. Once a target is mastered (ticked off 10 times), a new one is set. These might be linked to current learning or from past learning to improve their long term memory.
