Sterts Theatre Trip

As you can imagine, planning a whole school trip for 360 children and 60 adults is...shall we say...interesting!! But we love it, because we so rarely get the chance to do something like this, which is one of the curses of being such a huge school. There are now a few reminders for parents about the trip. Please try and make sure all of these are done ready for Thursday morning please:

- The cost of the trip is only £10. We are still very short of this, but hopefully, with pay day yesterday there might be a few more donations coming in.
- With the current amount having been paid, we should have cancelled this trip, but the cancellation policy of the theatre meant that we would have had to pay £1,600 even if we DIDN't go. It is therefore important that we reduce the deficit for the school by as much as possible please. If you would like to make a voluntary donation, the option is on ParentPay to do this.
- The buses have to leave at 9am, so it is vital that your child is in by 8.40am to enable them to go to the toilet and then get them on the bus.
- Year 5 and Year 6 will be on 4 buses parking at the front of school.
- Year 3 and 4 will be walking to the YMCA bus bay to get their buses.
- Please make sure your children has a packed lunch (one will be provided if your child is FSM and has asked for one).
- Please make sure your child has sun cream on (weather dependent), a sun hat and a waterproof (love British weather)!!!
- If your child gets travel sick, please make sure they have taken the tablet before, and that you contact the office if they need to take another one before they leave at 1.30pm.
- Due to the busy morning of coaches, if you can avoid driving to school that day it might be useful.
