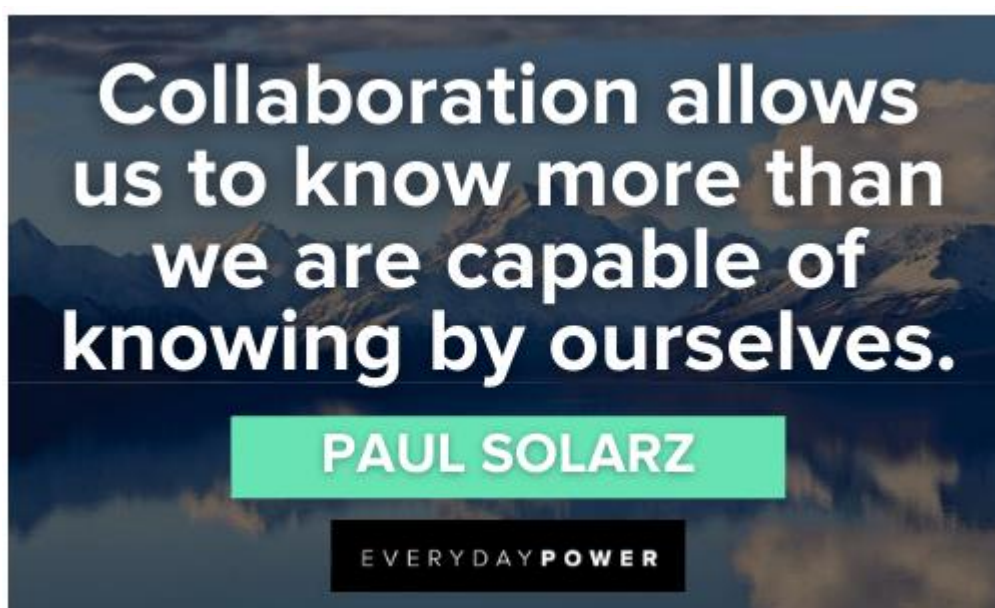
Year 6 Play
