













SEN Support Packs

As part of our provision to support children with additional needs, this summer we are sending some of the children home with a '6 Week Summer Pack'. The pack contains 6 activities - they can open one special envelope every week over the holidays! The packs are designed to encourage children and families to talk about the Autumn Term – so children are able to spend time processing any changes and new routines before they start the new year.

Often children with additional needs need regular short reminders to any changes or new routines – conversations little and often over the summer holidays will help them to maintain a connection with school, will give them time to work through any emotions they are feeling and will help them to develop a sense of security and acceptance.

School Works




