Design and make an ancient stone circle or a replica of Stonehenge. Be creative in the way you make your stone circle. Take a photo and either email it to Mr. Hamlyn or bring a photo into school.

Stone Age people made food from what they had caught or collected. Write your own recipe for a Stone Age dinner using the sort of ingredients that would be available to them.

The wheel was invented during the Stone Age. What is a wheel used for? Build something that uses a wheel/wheels.

Name the different types of stone used by Stone Age people. Describe what these stones were useful for and why. Present what you find out in any way you choose.
