

Attendance

As I mentioned in the last newsletter. The government are having a big push on attendance, and making sure children are in school as much as possible. The following couple of paragraphs were sent to all schools. Have a read, and check out the link about mild illnesses, as this might make it easier for you to judge when to send your children in.

"A new school year marks a fresh start for children to reconnect with friends and it's a chance to reset their patterns of behaviour, including attendance. Every professional adult and parent that interacts with a child plays an integral part in supporting children back to school.

We know that a small number of settings will be impacted by RAAC, but the vast majority are back to school as normal. We encourage you to promote the importance of attendance with parents. The first days matter. Last year, of those absent for at least one day in this period, 55% went on to be persistently absent.

You can help by resharing guidance on good attendance practices such as: <u>Is my child too ill for school?</u> to aid in making judgements about mild illness or how to seek support with attendance challenges.

The Chief Medical Officer and other health leaders have just written to schools on this, and their letter can be shared with parents to reinforce the messages."

I know we bang on about attendance a great deal, but I cannot stress the importance enough of getting your child to school on time and every day possible to ensure they are learning as much as they can! Thank you so much for your support in this.

End of Day Dismissals

I am sorry about the combined dismissal time. This is entirely on us, nothing to do with TCC, theirs has remained the same. It is all due to a mandatory opening duration of 32.5 hours from next September. TNIS and Carbeile have liaised regarding nursery openings, time for parents to get to both schools at the beginning and end of the day etc and this was literally the only combination that we could work out. I have also liaised with TCC and we will be trying to keep TCC students on the furthest pavement from the school so that Carbeile parents and children can stay on the nearest pavement to the school, and then hopefully there will be less congestion. We will also ensure that we dismiss on the button of 3.20pm, if not a minute or two before to ensure most of ours are out in good time. I will be adding something to the newsletter along these lines too. Thank you.

Dogs

Can I please remind parents that Carbeile and TCC is a dog-free site. There are however occasions where dogs are being used in order to aid the start of the school day for individual children, almost like a therapy dog. These are being risk assessed on an individual basis.

Could you also please avoid tying the dogs to the main gates outside. This is just in case the gates have to be opened for emergency vehicles.

Next Year


Some organised parents are trying to sort holidays for next summer. The children start back at Carbeile on Thursday 5th September 2024.
