ParentPay

Firstly, a huge thank you to you for making the change to the new ParentPay system so seamlessly. On Tuesday there were only 3 issues, which is amazing. I know this has been a faff for many of you, but thank you so much for taking the time to familiarise yourselves with the system and getting it all sorted.

Secondly, there are a few things to make you aware of that might make things even better.

- 1. We are going to change the label of the meals to the actual meal rather than the colour, so you can see what the meals are without having to refer to the menu.
- 2. We have discovered that you can make amendments to your bookings at any point during the week.
- 3. This means that you can order your child's meal last minute at 7.00am on the day you need it if necessary.
- 4. You can also cancel a meal you have ordered if circumstances have changed for any reason, or change the meal if your child changes their mind.
- 5. This also means that if your child is sick then you can still cancel your order.

We would still recommend you order in advance, but if you would like to have a bit more flexibility, this is also possible. Obviously, it still stands that if you have not ordered then you will have to send a packed lunch.

Hopefully this will now make it as easy as it has ever been, but without the school having to manage the weekly debt. Thank you again for your cooperation with all of these changes.

Can I also please request that you clear any ParentPay debt, even if you don't plan on using it for any lunches. There are still some debts that we are paying for.
