Federation

Just for your information, the two governing boards from Carbeile and Furlanesend unanimously voted to proceed with the federation proposal. This is after the 30-day consultation period had ended. We are now on the lookout for parent governors if anyone is interested. Please collect a form from reception, or complete the one that was emailed out. Thank you.

Attendance

It is very important to note that attendance will be properly cranking up a notch from September. Specifically, the changes are:

1. **A new national threshold of 10 unauthorised sessions for any reason (equivalent to 5 school days) within a rolling 10 school week period for which a penalty notice must be considered.** A penalty fine can be issued for any combination of unauthorised absences over a 10- week rolling period. They can be consecutive or non-consecutive and can span over two terms
2. **An increase in the penalty fine from £60 to £80 if paid in 21 days. If the fine is not paid by the first 21 days, it will rise to £160 if paid within 28 days of being issued**
3. **If a 2nd penalty fine is issued to the same parent for the same child within a 3-year rolling period, the fine will automatically rise to £160 with no option to pay the lower rate of £80**
4. **If a parent then commits a third offence in a 3-year rolling period, the local authority will need to consider options available to us to improve attendance. This will include a consideration to prosecute under section 444 of the Education Act 1996**
5. **The current penalty notice warning letter used for unauthorised absence (not holiday) will be changed to a Notice to Improve**

For an example, if two parents were to take two children on holiday during term time and it exceeded 5 days, they would instantly incur a £320 fine (£80 per child, per parent). Even if both parents do not go on the holiday, the other parent not attending can also be fined unless they make it clear that they are against the holiday taking place. This would double for a second incident, and move to prosecution for a third.

This also applies to any absences that the school deems as unauthorised, for example any unexplained absences.

Unfortunately, in line with DfE requirements, Carbeile has to follow these guidelines but we will continue to have a very open conversation with parents to give them chance to improve situations before any action is taken.

Year 6 Play

Just to let all Year 6 parents know that tickets for the show will be available to collect from Monday 8th July at reception. For now there is a limit of 2 tickets per child please. Extra tickets will become available when we know all parents have collected their preferred choice. I can't wait to see what they throw at us (literally) this time.
