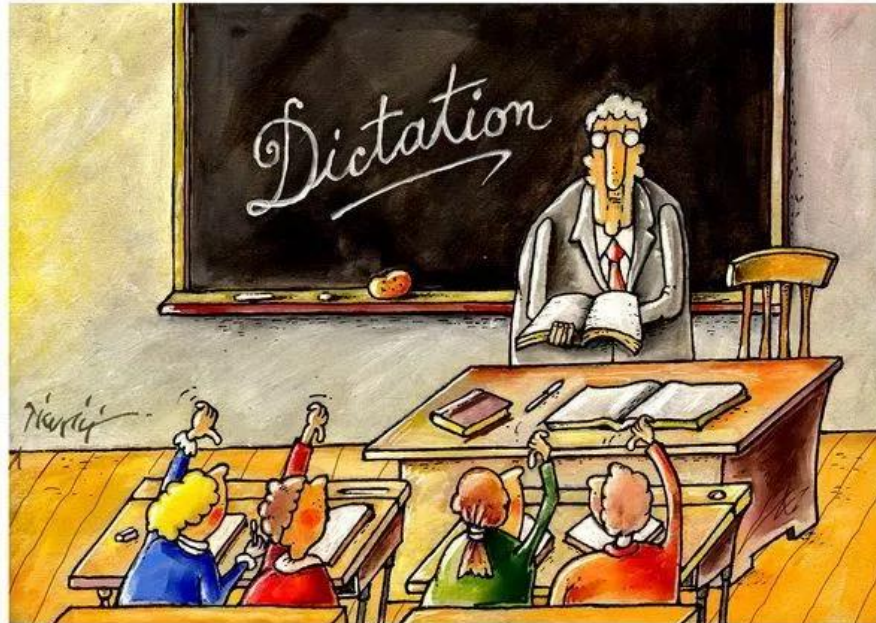

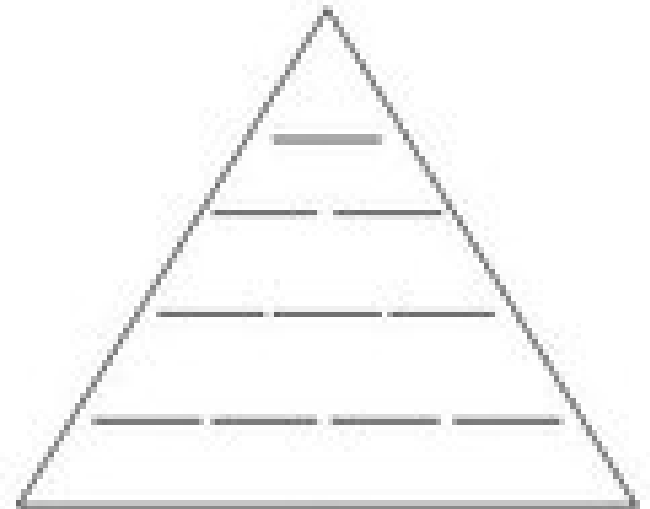
Dictation

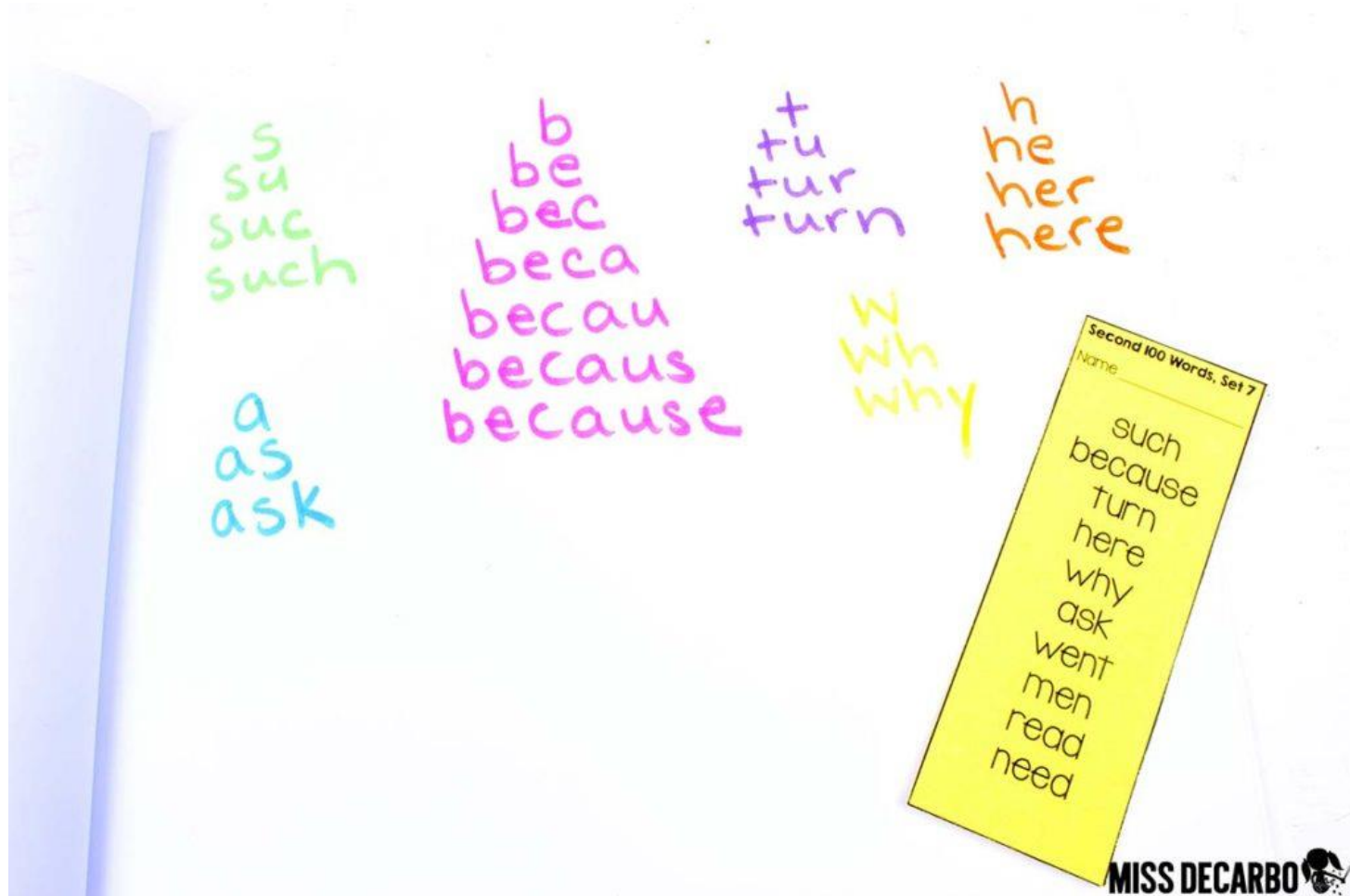


Pyramid Power

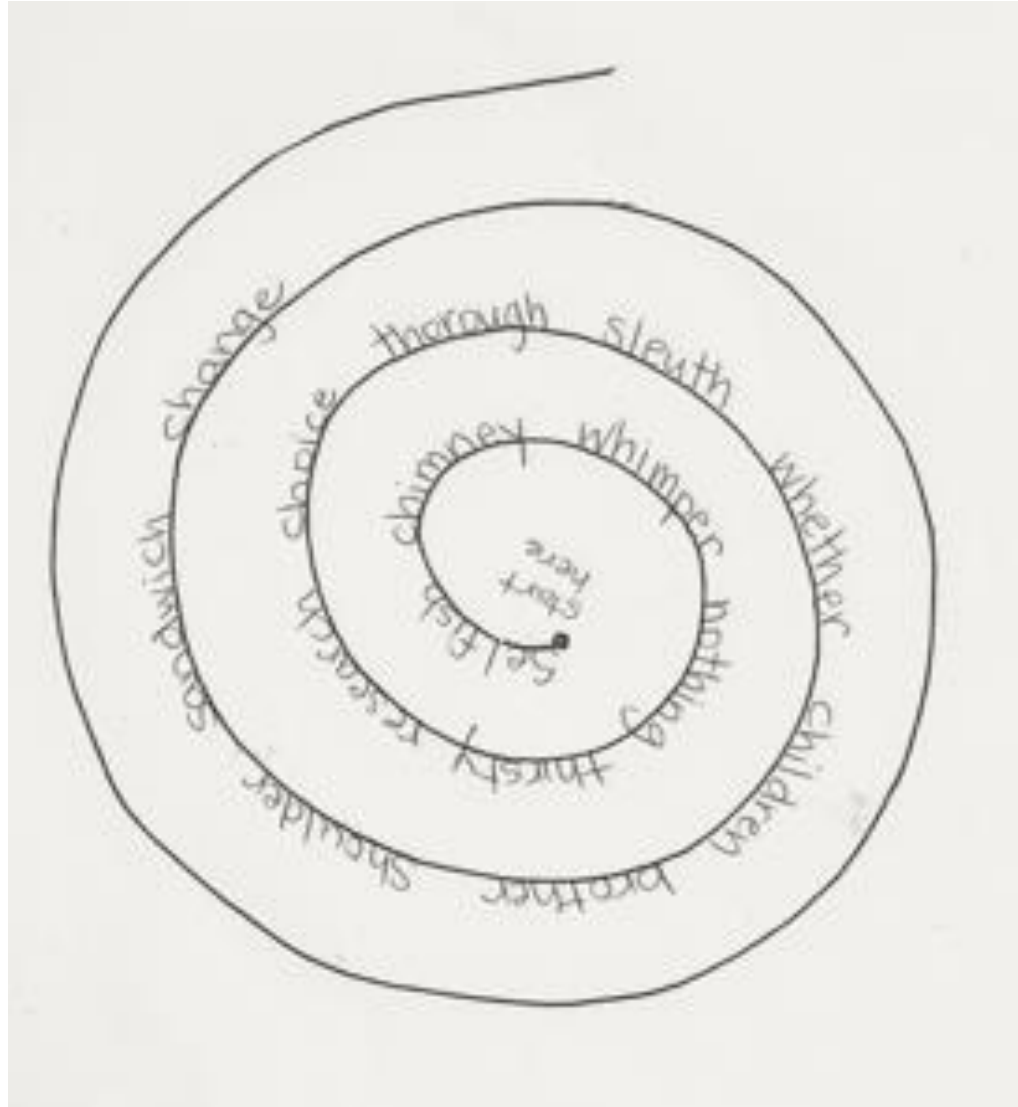
